- Discussing the challenges and possibilities of organising inclusive and sustainable cultural events in different European rural contexts.




- Learning tools to promote processes of inclusion of sexual and gender diversity in youth and rural organisations.


# WHERE: A Casa da Terra





**A Casa da Terra** is a sustainable accommodation in a small village located in the geographical centre of Galicia and less than 7km from the village of Monterroso, headquarters of the Festival Agrocuir. That is to say, in the region of A Ulloa itself, the area of influence of the festival's organising group, where the river Ulla flows, and the various projects and initiatives to be visited during the course are located. The surrounding natural context is composed of beautiful meadows and forests. The structure is equipped with a professional kitchen, a large dining room, one lodge with a capacity to accommodate 18 people and a room for comfortable group work.





